Bible Story – David and Goliath (1 Samuel 17:32-49)

Parent Recap: He may have been just a kid, but David saved a whole nation from a giant and the entire Philistine army. He did this because he believed that God was stronger than anything.

Main Point: Kids will learn that when we put our faith in God, we can serve God no matter our size.

Discussion Questions

- Can you think of a David vs. Goliath story you've seen in a movie or sports recently?
- Who was the Giant Slayer?
- Why was everyone else afraid to defeat Goliath?
- How did David kill Goliath?
- Why do you think God used David to kill the giant?
- Do you think God can use you to do big things?
- What is something you can do with God this week for your family or a friend?

Activity

Re-enactment Fun

• Have your kids act out a skit they create about David the Giant Slayer.

Craft Activity

• Have kids make a logo or patch for the "Giant Slayer" they can wear as a reminder that God can use kids to do his will.

Throughout the Week

- Talk about different David vs. Goliath stories you have seen in real life.
- Talk about different ways that God can use kids to do great things.
